Wallenberg syndrome

- Related to ischemia of the trigeminal nerve sensory nucleus leading to classic ipsilateral Horner's syndrome (ptosis, myosis, and anhydrosis) and
- Ipsilateral loss of facial sensation.
- Contralateral loss of pain and sensation from involvement of the spinothalamic tracK
