

Granular cell tumor (aka granular pituicytoma)

- Very Rare tumor: arising from pituicyte, a specialized glial cell in neurohypophysis and infundibulum.
- Visual and endocrine dysfunction common
- Peak incidence: 5th decade
- Best diagnostic clue:
 - Enhancing sellar or suprasellar mass arising from neurohypophysis or stalk
 - Location: Typically suprasellar (infundibular); pure intrasellar less common

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
